EPS Panel Site Delivery Protocol



Delivery of EPS Panels

- Reasonable access via paved/safe roads to approach site is required, including access to site through multi-unit developments.
- Safe/legal parking access at the front of site is required.
- Client must provide help to unload, carry and place product on site.
- Unipod needs to be advised of any of the following before delivery is able to be completed: Low clearance tree branches, overhanging wires /powerlines, roads made of dirt or mud. Regardless of notice, access to site needs to be safe, unrestricted and achievable.
- Low clearance vehicles having less carrying capacity, can result in extra deliveries being required to get the order volumes to site compared to standard trucks.
- Clear access to the block is needed – minimum 1.5m width – without obstacles being present such as piles of earth, reo, formwork, trenches etc.
- Deliveries cannot be completed “at the back of the block”.
- Placement of deliveries on “next door blocks” or nature strips etc will be performed only at customers request and with customers taking full responsibility.
- Unipod allows 45 minutes for delivery including tie down. Requests to wait, failed deliveries, late cancellations will be charged as demurrage at appropriate rates.



Recycling Clean Up

- Full scrap panels are to be secured at front of site to avoid being blown offsite. Do not place reo, wood, stones and so on to secure.
- All recyclable EPS is to be kept separate from other materials. EPS covered in mud, concrete or any other contaminants will not be collected from site. Only clean EPS waste will be collected from the site.
- Panels for recycling will not be picked up if not placed at front of site.
- Only Unipod EPS material will be collected.
- Material cannot be recycled after extended exposure (2 months) to the elements. This product will not be collected.
- Collections that are unable to be completed due to the stated protocols not being adhered to, will be treated as failed collections requiring rebooking.
